- 1. A list of journal articles that we will be reading and discussing as a group will be provided at the beginning of the semester. Select the week you would like to present and then locate the corresponding article. If there is more than one article assigned please select which one you prefer to present to the group for discussion.
- 2. Plan to spend approximately **15 minutes** on your article presentation. We will also save a few minutes for questions or comments at the end.
- 3. Please use the following format when presenting your article for the week:
  - a. A few words about **why you selected** this particular article (if there is more than one to choose from for the week)
  - b. Present the Title, year of publication, authors and institutional affiliations
  - c. Remind us of any **funding/grant support sources** (e.g., NIH institute, Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, etc.)
  - d. Acknowledge the location/region where the study was conducted
  - e. Review the study's key objectives or aims
  - f. Summarize the study's **methodology** (i.e. study design, number of participants, sample characteristics, measures used, statistical analyses performed, etc.)
  - g. Provide a description of the study's key **results** or major findings
  - h. What **conclusions** are able to be drawn from the results?
  - i. Briefly discuss the study's **strengths** and **limitations** (i.e. critiquing how well the study was designed to meet its primary objectives)
  - j. Suggest **future** areas of **related research** or in what ways you would want to follow-up on this study
  - k. Open it up to the rest of the group with any questions or comments you had (e.g., things you found interesting, confusing, etc.) that you would like to discuss further
