### PLANNED PRODUCTS AND ACTIVITIES

- Revamp the website and other communication media
- Devise strategies and materials for workshops at professional meetings
- Produce an inventory of current social sustainability assessment tools to identify gaps and problems
- Develop a handbook of course curricula, communicating experiences with social sustainability
- Develop ways to engage the general public in social sustainability conversations through art and other means
- Initiate a research agenda for funding.

#### ASSESSMENT

- After the 2013 Inaugural Conference:
- almost 97% of attendees said that their understanding of social sustainability was improved by the conference.
- Attendees found the event intellectually stimulating (91%)
- Attendees met new contacts they will likely use (79%)
- Attendees met new potential collaborators (57%)
- Attendees could see ways that social sustainability related to their work that they did not see before (50%).
